Terms of Agreement

The above named horse, herein known as the "adopted horse," is in good health and sound at time of adoption. The person adopting the horse, herein known as "the adopted party," understands that the adopted horse is owned by Mt. Hope Horse Rescue, Inc. and shall not at any time be sold, traded or rented out without written consent of the owner of Mt. Hope Horse Rescue, Inc., herein known as "MHHR."

The adopted horse may be shown in fairs and at riding clubs; however, the adopting party must treat the adopted horse with respect and care. Failure, at any time, to treat the adopted horse in a humane and loving manner would be cause for cancellation of the adoption agreement.

The adopting party agrees not to breed the adopted horse without prior written approval or signed consent by MHHR.

The adopting party agrees to the following terms:

- Records of farrier appointments must be forwarded to MHHR three (3) times a year;
- Shot records, including Coggins, must be forwarded to MHHR two (2) times a year;
- The adopted horse's teeth must be floated or examined by registered profession at least one (1) time a year;
- The adopted horse must be wormed at least six (6) times a year.

MHHR reserves the right to inspect the boarding facility conditions of the adopted horse, wherever it may be. Agents of MHHR also retain the rights to inspect the boarding facility conditions of the adopted horse.

The adopting party agrees to notify MHHR in writing via certified mail if the adopted horse is transported and moved from present location to another location, and the adopting party agrees to provide the physical address of the new location.

In the case of marital discord, loss of job, and/or need to relocate, the adopting party is hereby notified that the adopted horse should not be subjected to any type of neglect. In the possible situations of family issues or loss of sufficient income to support the adopted horse, MHHR should be contacted immediately to pick-up the adopted horse.

Cancellation of Agreement

If at any time MHHR feels that the adopted horse is not being taken care of to their satisfaction, the adoption agreement will be cancelled.

Any abuse, neglect or failure to adhere to above conditions is cause for cancellation of the adoption agreement and rights.

If any violation to this adoption agreement occurs, MHHR has the right to seize the adopted horse.

Please be aware that failure to be reached when contacted may result in a negative report on the adopted horse. MHHR will first attempt to contact the party via telephone regarding the care of the adopted horse. If unable to reach the party, MHHR will send certified

correspondence via United States Postal Service. Failure to respond to written correspondence within thirty (30) days will raise issues of concern of suspicious activity. MHHR will then retain the right to pick-up the adopted horse and cancel the adoption agreement.

Proper Identification

Proper identification must be supplied with Adoption Agreement for application to be processed. A copy of the adopted party's valid PA driver's license must be attached.
